

Proclamation

WHEREAS, the Code of Ordinances for the City of Longwood, Florida, provides that the Mayor will issue a Proclamation giving at least fifteen (15) days notice of the qualification period for an election, stating the time, place and naming the issues to be voted on; and

WHEREAS, an advertisement for this Election shall be advertised twice in a newspaper of general circulation in the County; and

NOW, THEREFORE, I, JOSEPH DURSO, MAYOR OF THE CITY OF LONGWOOD, FLORIDA, do hereby proclaim that the City of Longwood will hold an Election on Tuesday, March 15, 2016, from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. Registered voters of Longwood will vote at the precinct indicated on their voter's identification cards at the locations listed below:

Precinct 19: Longwood Community Building, 200 West Warren Avenue, Longwood

Precinct 20: Longwood Elementary School, 840 Orange Avenue, Longwood


This Election will be held for the purpose of a referendum with one question submitted to the voters, in accordance with Ordinance No. 15-2072.
