Boards and Committees

CITIZEN VOLUNTEERS ARE NEEDED TO SERVE ON VARIOUS CITY ADVISORY BOARDS. IF YOU ARE INTERESTED IN SERVING ON ONE OF THE CITY BOARDS, PLEASE CONTACT THE OFFICE OF THE CITY CLERK IF YOU HAVE ANY QUESTIONS.

***Board of Adjustment:** Authorizes variances and special exceptions to the zoning code; hears and decides appeals to administrative decisions. Meets on 4th Wednesday of each month at 7:00 p.m. Five member board; qualified voter of the city; 3 year terms. (Meets only as required.)

***Land Planning Agency:** Reviews and recommends amendments to Comprehensive Plan, Land Development Code, right-of-way abandonments, annexation. Meets on 2nd Wednesday of the month at 7:00 p.m. Five member board; qualified voter of the city; 3 year terms.

***Parks and Recreation Advisory Board:** Assists in the development of plans to meet the present and future parks and recreational needs of the City. Meets on the 1st Tuesday of each month at 7:00 p.m. Seven member board; all city residents; 3 year terms.

***Pension Board:** Reviews and administers the Police Officers/Firefighters Pension Plan. Meets at 7:00 p.m. on the third Tuesday of March, June, September, and December. Five member board (2 members of which are residents, 2 members of pension plan, 1 member nominated by Board members).

In addition to the standing boards, ad hoc committees may convene from time to time, i.e., Charter Review.

***except as noted the majority of board members shall be city residents. Boards preceded by an asterisk (*) require Financial Disclosure.**
